



Cascades Steps

Updating Breastfeeding “Unknown” Status in the Health Information Screen

This Cascades Steps show when a breastfeeding participant changes the breastfeeding status in the Health Information screen. The steps below are to correct the "Ever Breastfed" status to "Yes" when the system defaults to "Unknown" in two places in Cascades—in the Infant Health Information screen and Breastfeeding Peer Counseling Care Plan.

Steps	Cascades Screen
<p>Step 1: Reflect and affirm the participant's infant feeding choice.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participant states they stopped breastfeeding. Offer support. Offer support. Complete a brief assessment to confirm whether there is a need for breastfeeding support or not. 	
<p>Step 2: Change the infant feeding method.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select the infant icon to access the infant's record. From Quick Links, go to Health Information. 	



Cascades Steps

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Step 3: Update "Ever Breastfed."

- Go to the **Breastfeeding Information container**.
- Update **BF Information questions**:
 - a. Enter the date when breastfeeding stopped.
 - b. Update **Are you breastfeeding?**
 - Change "Yes" to "No"
 - c. Notice that **Ever Breastfed** changes from "Yes" to "Unknown."
 - Note the greyed out **Age Infant Stopped Breastfeeding**, and **Reason Infant Stopped Breastfeeding** at the default response to "Unknown."
 - d. Change "Unknown" to "Yes."
 - Now you can update **Age Infant Stopped Breastfeeding** and **Reason Infant Stopped Breastfeeding**.

Cascades Steps

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Step 4: Breastfeeding Information.

- Complete all starred questions and other non-required information in the Breastfeeding Information section.
 - Aged Infant Stopped Breastfeeding
 - Reasons Infant Stopped Breastfeeding
 - Age Supplement was given
 - Do you give your baby any formula?
 - How much formula do you give your infant in a 24-hour period?
 - Complications, if needed.
